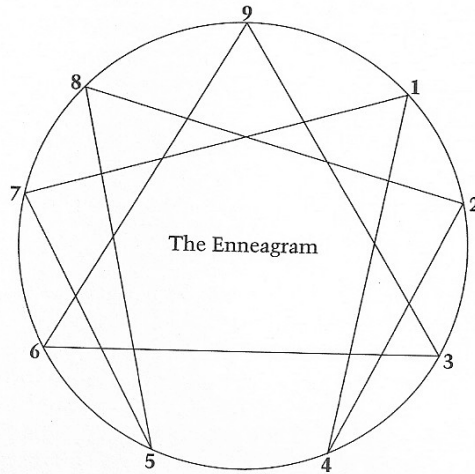


***The Enneagram Workshop
